



## Quintin Solomon Alvarez

Quintin Solomon Alvarez, beloved only son to Herminio Alvarez Jr and the late Karen Marie White, died on Monday, February 6, 2017 at his home in Keasby, New Jersey.

Quinny, which was his family nickname, was born on a hot summer day in Brooklyn, NY on July 21, 1996. As a child, living in the Bronx, he loved to read and picnic in the Botanical Gardens, go to the Bronx Zoo, and whenever possible go to the beach with his mom. Quinny will always be remembered as a bright meteoric shooting star with extraordinary gifts and talents that awed every one of us. He was a quiet soft spoken young gentle man with a million-dollar smile who we are all so lucky to have blessed with his love. He will live on in all of us.
